

Next Level Revision – Frequently Asked Questions

What subjects do you offer tuition for?

Our courses are for Maths and Science. Our camps are all core subjects, humanities and languages.

Which exam boards do your courses cover?

Our exam boards are tailored to support the AQA and Edexcel exam boards.

How do your courses support the higher and foundation tiers?

We tailor our support to meet the needs of both higher and foundation tier students using targeted resources, flexible teaching strategies, personalised feedback and exam preparation.

What is the group size for each class?

Our groups never exceed 14 students.

How do we choose our tutors?

We follow a rigorous selection process to ensure students learn from the best. We also follow Safer Recruitment processes.

How does the multi-site option work for the combination course?

You will attend both the GCSE Maths and GCSE Science course, however you will do so at different sites and on different evenings. For example, Maths on Tuesday at Slough and Eton, and then Science on Wednesday at The Langley Academy.

What happens if my child is absent from a session?

We can provide a spot in one of our other classes that week. If you cannot attend there, we will give you all resources to catch up the following week.

How is each session structured?

In 3 parts: Group Homework Review, Group Tuition and then 1:1 Support.

What is the difference between group learning and 1:1 support?

Group learning encourages collaboration, discussion and shared problem-solving. Whilst 1:1 support offers personalised attention, tailored teaching and focused feedback.

How do you personalise the learning for each student?

We assess each student's strengths, gaps and goals and then tailor our resources and feedback to develop their learning.

What revision or wellbeing support is provided?

We regularly send out revision tips and tricks. We also provide a support group, which sends out wellness ideas and suggestions, and is there to support the whole journey.

How do you track my child's progress?

We have 3 assessment points, however progress is mapped during each lesson too.

Are books and materials included in the course fee?

Absolutely. All books, stationary, resources, test packs, are included in the course fee.

Can I switch to the course combination package after booking a single subject?

Provided availability, we can switch you to the course combination package.
